



The Wellington Regional Sports Awards 2024

Terms & Conditions for Nominations

All Nominations for the Wellington Regional Sports Awards 2024 must comply with and consent to the Terms and Conditions below:

The following general conditions apply to all nomination categories:

1. An athlete/person can be nominated in more than one category. Please fill in a separate form for each nomination.
2. All nominations must be submitted on the online nomination form on the Wellington Regional Sports Awards website (www.wellingtonsportsawards.co.nz).
3. If you have supporting videos or audio, please submit this in a MP3, MP4, MOV format.
4. If your nominee is selected as a finalist, your supporting imagery will be used at the Wellington Regional Sports Awards 2024 awards function and may be used by the organiser at its discretion, for media stories, case studies and/or promotion of the Wellington Regional Sports Awards 2024.
5. If you do not submit supporting imagery, and your nominee is subsequently chosen as a finalist, you or the nominee must then provide relevant supporting imagery.
6. All finalists and winners will be selected by an independent judging panel from the nominations that have been submitted.
7. All nominees shall have been involved in their sport at local, regional, national, or international level whichever the individual award category states. (Please refer to the specific Wellington Regional Sports Awards 2024 Nomination Criteria).
8. All nominations must relate to achievements within the period 1st April 2023 – 1st April 2024. Supporting documentation dating from outside this period may be provided, if clearly identified as such and if directly related to the achievement period of 1st April 2023 – 1st April 2024.
9. Nominations will close at 11.59pm on Monday 5th August 2024. Nominations received after this date will not be judged.
10. The judges shall be entitled to follow-up and authenticate any information, or material provided in any nomination. A nomination may be deemed ineligible for consideration if the information or material provided cannot be verified to the judge's satisfaction.
11. The judges reserve the right to have the final say in the eligibility of any person nominated.
12. A nominee will only be chosen as a finalist for the Award if the judges consider that the calibre of the nomination has met the nomination criteria and is of an appropriate standard of quality (to be determined at the Judges' sole discretion). The judges will

- determine whether there are any, and if so, the number of finalists.
13. The Judges shall also be entitled to deny entry to any nominee, or terminate any entry, at any time, if in their opinion any application or entry could bring the Wellington Regional Sports Awards into disrepute.
 14. The Judges' decisions shall always be final, and no correspondence will be considered regarding their decisions.
 15. The nominator grants the Organiser a royalty-free, sub-licensable and transferable right to reproduce, publish and/or broadcast either in full or in part any portion of the applicant's entry or supporting imagery (as set out in condition 4 above) to the Awards for the purposes of case study, media stories and/or promotion of the Wellington Regional Sports Awards.
 16. If any information or material provided by a nominator is of a commercially or personally sensitive nature that may be detrimental to the nominee or a third party if published or broadcast, the nominator must clearly make that information or material "CONFIDENTIAL" and the Organiser agrees not to publish or broadcast that information or material except to the extent permitted in writing by the nominee/award recipient.
 17. The Organiser owns all promotion and publicity rights to the Wellington Regional Sports Awards 2024.
 18. The Organiser shall have no liability resulting from the use of, or reliance on, any information provided to the Organiser by the nominator or nominee in respect of the Wellington Regional Sports Awards 2024, and the nominator and nominee agree to indemnify the Organiser from all claims, demands, costs (including legal costs on a solicitor and own client basis), losses, expenses and damages arising out of the Organiser's permitted use of such information, including the nomination entry.
 19. The finalists selected will be contacted directly by the Organiser and must agree to be bound to the same Terms and Conditions of the Wellington Regional Sports Awards in order to be progressed for further consideration by the Judges.

Collection of Personal Information:

Nuku Ora, Organiser of the Wellington Regional Sports Awards 2024 is committed to respecting your privacy and ensuring the security of any personal information you provide to them. You acknowledge that any personal information you provide to Nuku Ora via this nomination form or otherwise, will be processed by Nuku Ora in accordance with their Privacy Policy and all applicable privacy laws, including the Privacy Act 2020 (NZ) (Privacy Act) and the sections below. Please refer to Nuku Ora's Privacy Policy for further details.

Nuku Ora will collect personal information regarding the nominators and the nominees to facilitate the judging process, contact finalists and for the subsequent event organisation. The personal information being collected for nominations is for the purpose of organising the Wellington Regional Sports Awards 2024 and any future Wellington Regional Sports Awards. This information will be held safely and securely by Nuku Ora and may be shared with any future organisers of the event.

- I consent to Nuku Ora entering my personal details and the nominees' personal details contained on the nomination forms into the Event database which will be used for the administration of the Event.
 - I consent to the release of my personal details and nominees' personal details, as included in this registration to medical assistance personnel and Event organisers in the event of a medical emergency during participation in the Event.
 - I agree to the above consents regarding the collection and use of Personal Information.

I acknowledge that Nuku Ora will also use the personal information I provide:

- to monitor, respond to and/or keep records of Nuku Ora's e-mail communications and other correspondence with you;
- to provide the Event services, provide me with information in respect of the Event and other related services, generate invoices and other payment-related documentation;
- in order to detect and/or prevent any illegal activity that may threaten the Event or Nuku Ora where necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims. Nuku Ora may also use my personal information where necessary for the purposes of obtaining or maintaining insurance, managing risks and/or obtaining professional advice; and in order to comply with any applicable laws and/or regulations or in order to protect my vital interests or the vital interests of another natural person.

I consent to Nuku Ora disclosing the information provided by me:

- to Judges and Regional Sports Organisations associated with the Event.
- to medical or emergency response personnel in the event of a personal or medical emergency;
- to contractors and suppliers who assist and enable Nuku Ora to use my personal information to support delivery of the Event and related services to me;

- where the disclosure is otherwise required by law or in order to protect my vital interests or the vital interests of another natural person.
